Ecolab Rodent Attractant – Contents statement

Dear Sir/ Madam,

Ecolab rodent attractant is a formulation of sunflower seeds and is exempt from an MSDS due to the fact that this ingredient is based on agricultural seeds as well as being a foodstuff item and In terms of EU regulations:

Partial Exemptions

In addition to those substances which are totally exempt from REACH, there are a number of substances which are exempt from only certain aspects of REACH. This is often because they are used in products which fall under the scope of more specific legislation. These are listed below together with the relevant article of the REACH text and the part of REACH from which they are exempt.

1. Substances contained within products falling into scope of the following European Directives and Regulations are exempted from the following parts of REACH: Title II (Registration); Title V (Downstream Users); Title VI (Evaluation); Title VII (Authorisation)

Food and Feedingstuffs in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 [Article 2(5)(b)]; including use

- as a food additive in foodstuffs within the scope of Directive 89/107/EEC;
- as a flavouring in foodstuffs within the scope of Directive 88/388/EEC and Directive 1999/217/EC drawn up in application of Regulation (EC) No 2232/96;
- as an additive in feeding stuffs within scope of Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003;
- in animal nutrition within the scope of Directive 82/471/EEC.

The contents of the rodent attractant have been declared as a formulation of:

- Sunflower seeds (> 84 %)
- Permitted emulsifiers and sugars (# 471)
- Permitted antioxidants and salts (# 306)
